<answer> **FCC Rules 15.250, 15.253, 15.255, 15.257, 15.521 include provisions that prohibit operation of certain unlicensed devices on aircraft, satellites [and other conditions, as applicable to particular Rule Parts]. The FCC has a long-standing precedent that a statement in the user manual has been sufficient to show compliance to these provisions.**

3. The installer's and user's manuals should include use restrictions (toys, aircraft, ship, and satellite) per FCC Rule §15.521(a), as well as information to users as specified in §15.21.

<answer>pls see **revised Installer Manual and User Manual.**

4. Please provide a more detailed explanation of the spurious emission at 1597 MHz identified in the output power measurements. What digital circuitry is being referred to? Is the circuitry in the device or in the test set-up?

<answer> **The device includes associated digital device circuitry to provide additional functions and capabilities other than the UWB transmission. The test mode software enables the UWB transmissions to be turned off, independent of the digital circuitry. This digital circuitry is in the device.**

5. Please confirm compliance with 10-second shutoff requirement in §15.519(a)(1).

<answer> pls see Page 5 of the User Manual. The FCC has a long-standing precedent that a statement in the Operational Description, User Manual, or Part 7 of a Modular Approval letter has been sufficient to show compliance to the 10-second transmission cessation requirement. Additionally KDB 393764 does not include any test procedures for this requirement.
