I have a few comments on this Application. Depending on your responses, kindly understand there may be additional comments.

- 1.) Rule 15.19(a)(1) requires that "...Receivers associated with the operation of a licensed radio service, e.g., FM broadcast under part 73 of this chapter, land mobile operation under part 90, etc., shall bear the following statement in a conspicuous location on the device: 'This device complies with part 15 of the FCC Rules. Operation is subject to the condition that this device does not cause harmful interference.' " The required compliance statement appears is missing from the label, nor does it appear in the Manual. Please provide the exact artwork as this device will be labeled.
- 2.) Page 4 of the Test Report indicates that this is a 'CDMA-FM' device. If so, then am I to assume that AMPS-FM is also an operational mode for this equipment? If so, kindly present AMPS-FM test data and revise your Form 731.
- 3.) The Manual indicates this device can be connected to a computer via a data cable (page 17). Was this equipment tested as a "Computer Peripheral"? If so, then either DoC or Certification as a Class B Computer Peripheral may apply. If DoC then the FCC logo should appear on the label. Your comments please?
- 4.) The SAR report indicates that five different models are covered by this one SAR report. What are the different features which distinguish these models? Were all models tested for SAR compliance?
- 5.) Photographs showing the placement against the phantom showing both the head and body positions during SAR testing are missing from the RF Exposure exhibit. In addition, a photograph showing the minimum 15cm tissue depth is missing too. Kindly revise or supplement your SAR report.
- 6.) Please provide a photograph of the holster used during SAR testing. Please confirm if it does/does not contain any metal.
