In regards to your recent TCB application referenced above, we kindly request that you provide the following additional information.

1. The BT Operational Description does not address the RFF portion of the EUT. Please revise and resubmit.

2. Please provide RF conducted plots demonstrating compliance of the CDMA transmitter 1 MHz removed from each bandedge, using RBW = 100 kHz, per Section 22.917(b).
[==> We added the plots to the RF Test report on page 19-20 of 23.](#)
3. The SAR report (p.23/53) addresses WCDMA, but not standard CDMA. Please indicate the RC/SO combination used for testing, and revise the report.
[==> Please find the revised SAR report on page 23-24/54.](#)
[Head SAR was tested under RC3/SO55 and Body SAR was tested under RC3/SO32.](#)
4. The user's manual lists an optional extended battery, but this was not tested. Please either remove this reference from the manual and resubmit it, and do not supply an extended battery for use with the EUT, or else, provide EMC and SAR data with this battery.
[==> Please find the revised User Manual. The extended battery doesn't supply.](#)
5. FYI: ANSI C63.4 requires that a 10 cm spacing be maintained between all items on the test stand. In the future please be sure that this is the case.

The item indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application.
