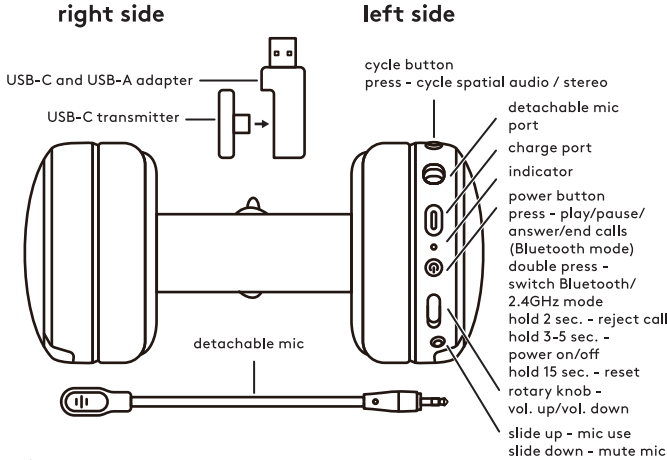

wireless over-ear gaming headset



included

- Wireless over-ear gaming headset
- USB-C transmitter
- USB-C and USB-A adapter
- USB-C charging and audio cable
- Detachable microphone

indicators

- Flash red and white alternately - pairing/re-pairing (in Bluetooth mode)
- Solid white - paired/streaming/ receiver connected/active call
- Flashing white - receiver connecting
- Rapid flashing white - incoming call/reject call/pairing(in 2.4 GHz mode)
- Solid red - low power/charging
- Red light off - charging complete

- Swish tone - power on
- Descending tones - power off
- Descending double chime - ready to pair
- Ascending double chime - paired
- Low descending tune - low battery
- Rapid descending tones - spatial audio mode on
- Rapid ascending tones - stereo audio mode on

quick tip

- This headset is equipped with 7.1 surround sound which can be activated by pressing the cycle button once to switch between stereo and spatial audio.

Bluetooth pairing

- When headset is off, press and continuously hold the power button for 3 seconds until indicator flashes red and white alternately
- Use the Bluetooth settings on your phone to pair with KPOP x Heyday Headphones
- Solid white light on - pairing successful

Note: Hold the power button for 3 seconds to power on, and 5 seconds to power off

connect via USB-C transmitter

- If your device is equipped with a USB-A port, use the included USB-C & USB-A adapter as the receiver. If your device has a USB-C port, remove the USB-C transmitter from the USB-C & USB-A adapter, then plug it into your device or console. The receiver separates horizontally to access the USB-C transmitter.
- The headset defaults to 2.4 GHz mode on first power-up and remembers the last used mode afterwards. Double press the power button to switch to Bluetooth mode if needed.
- During 2.4 GHz pairing, the headset flashes white rapidly, and the receiver flashes white. After successful pairing, both stay solid white.

charging

- Plug USB-C end of charger into headset.
- Plug opposite end of charging cable into a power supply of at least DC 5V 1A.
- **WARNING:** Please use UL compliant power supply.
- Full charge requires approximately 2 hours, with up to 70 hours of playback time via Bluetooth or 75 hours via 2.4GHz wireless at full charge.
- Charging is complete when red light turns off.

line in

- Insert the included cable into the USB-C port of the headset.
- Plug the other end into the media source.

troubleshooting

- If the headset is not working correctly, power it off and hold the power button for 15 seconds to reset.
- If the headset won't turn on, recharge the battery and try again.
- If the headset won't charge, make sure the power supply works, is 5V 1A, and not damaged.
- If the headset make no sound or does not show as an available device, make sure they are not paired to a different device already.
- To re-enter pairing mode, power off the headset first. Press and hold the power button for 5 seconds until you hear the swish tone. The unit will then enter Bluetooth pairing mode.
