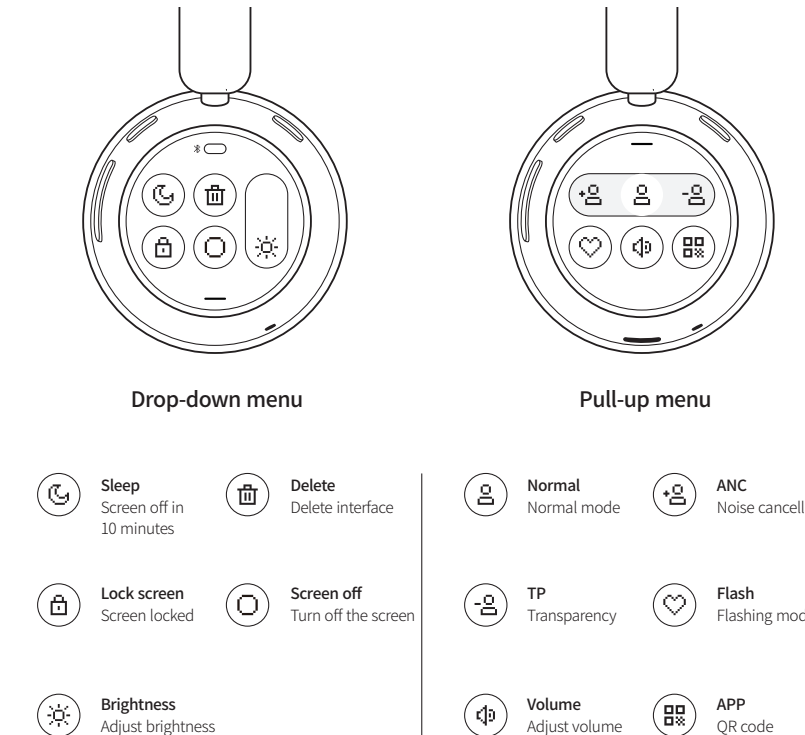
If the headset has connection or function issues, please reset the headset:

- When the headset is powered on and connected (or not connected), press the power button five times
 - Delete the Bluetooth pairing information of the device and turn off Bluetooth
 - Power on again, wait for the headset, and re-pair/connect with your device.
- (If the above steps do not work, please retry)

Screen operations



APP connection

- Turn on Bluetooth on your phone, open the app, and tap "Add Device"
- Wait for the device to appear: "H3"
- Select the matching color on the device page and tap to complete pairing

Content upload

Single image

- Tap Single Image. Choose Camera/Album
- Select a photo and adjust size
- Preview and Upload

GIF/Video

- Tap Video. Choose GIF/Video
- Select a video and trim it
- Preview and Upload

Slideshow

- Tap Slideshow. Set the interval
- Tap Add and select multiple photos
- Arrange order and Upload

Tips

- Higher brightness= more battery use
- Video/GIF transfers take longer
- If frozen, hold power Ts to restart
