



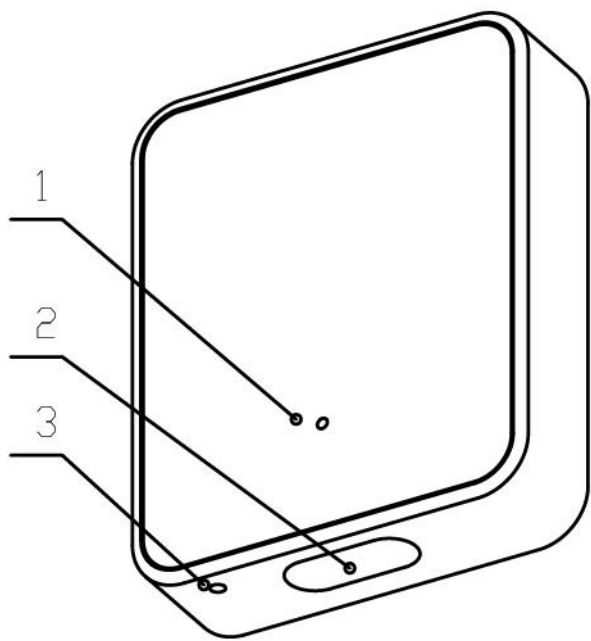

# 1. Product Introduction

## 2.How to use?

### Device binding:

1.Scan the QR code on the device, packaging, or image below with your mobile phone to download the app.



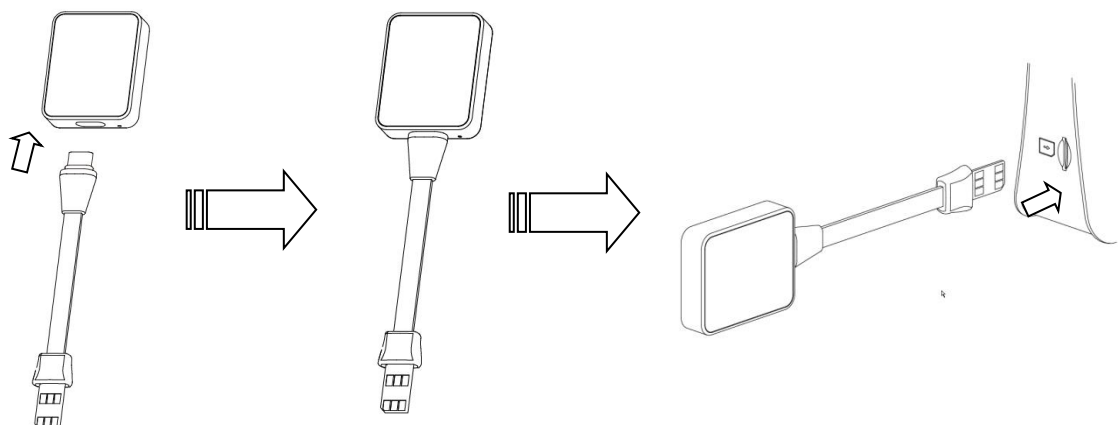
2.Register for a GlocalMe account: Open the app and register for an account.



3.Log in to your account on the mobile app interface, then click “My Devices” — “Bind Device” and scan the QR code on the device to bind it.



4.Turn on the device: Connect the Type-C adapter to the CloudSIM kit and insert the corresponding card tray into the terminal device.



5. After waiting for the green light to stay on, the terminal device can successfully register for Internet access.

Note:

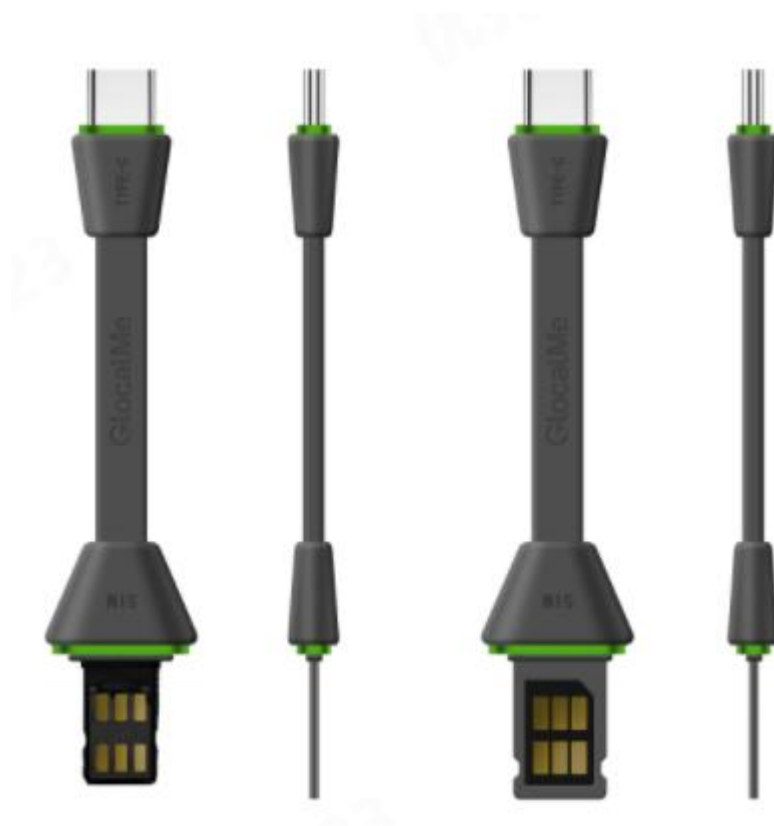
1. Charge the device for 20 to 30 minutes before inserting the SIM card.
2. Ensure that the card slot of the adapter cable matches the device.

Special reminder:

It is recommended to use the device in an ambient temperature range of 0°C to +35°C. Avoid using the device in environments with extremely high or low temperatures. Do not leave the device exposed to direct sunlight for extended periods of time. Do not seal the device in packaging. Avoid using the device in humid environments.

Adapter cable accessories:

Depending on the SIM card slot type (2FF, 3FF, 4FF, or card tray slot), different types of adapter cables are available. Please select the appropriate adapter cable before use.

## 4. Q&A

1. Q: What should I do if the work indicator light is flashing?

A: If the device is still flashing after 5 minutes of startup, 1. Check if the connection is normal and if the terminal device can read the card. If the card is read but cannot be registered, check if the package is still valid. If the package is still valid, remove the cloudsims kit, charge it for 20 minutes, and then re-verify. Consider moving to a location with better signal strength and restarting the device.

2. Q: What should I do if the work indicator light is not on?

A: Check that the connection cable is properly connected. Or recharge for 20 minutes and then reconnect the device.

3. Q: The terminal displays that the card has been read, but registration fails. What should I do?

A: Check whether the package is still valid. If it is valid, remove the cloudsims kit, charge it for 20 minutes, and then re-verify it. Consider moving to a location with better signal strength and restarting the device.

### CAUTION

### Warning

Specific Absorption Rate (SAR) refers to the rate at which the body absorbs RF energy. The SAR limit is 1.6 watts per kilogram in countries that set the limit averaged over 1 gram of

tissue and 2.0 watts per kilogram in countries that set the limit averaged over 10 grams of tissue. During testing, the device are set to their highest transmission levels in all tested frequency bands, although the SAR is determined at the highest certified power level, the actual SAR level of the device while operating can be well below the maximum value.

#### EU Regulatory conformance

The device complies with RF specifications and when used with an accessory that contains no metal and that positions the device a minimum of 0.5 cm from the body.

The SAR limit adopted is 2.0W/kg averaged over 10 grams of tissue. The highest SAR value reported for the device when properly worn on the body complies with the limit. Hereby, UCLOUDLINK (SINGAPORE) PTE.LTD.declares that this device is in compliance with the essential requirements and other relevant provisions of Directive (RED) 2014/53/EU.

#### FCC Regulatory conformance

For body worn operation, the device complies with FCC RF exposure guidelines and when used with an accessory that contains no metal and that positions the device a minimum of 0.5 cm from the body.

The SAR limit adopted by the FCC is 1.6W/kg averaged over 1 gram of tissue. The highest SAR value reported for the device when properly worn on the body complies with the limit.

This device complies with part 15 of the FCC Rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions: (1) This device may not cause harmful interference, and (2) this device must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation. Any Changes or modifications not expressly approved by the party responsible for compliance could void the user's authority to operate the equipment.
