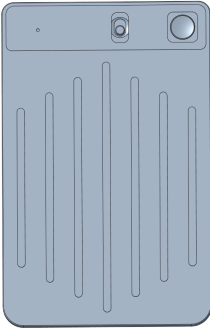

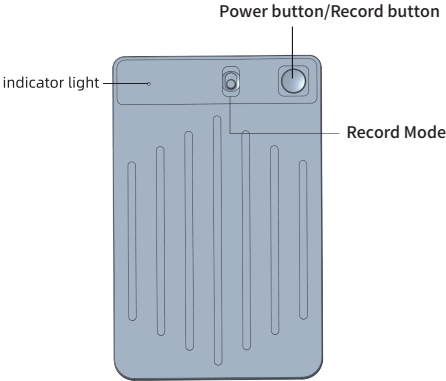

2. Product Introduction

Thank you for using our products.

This product is a mobile phone back-stick voice recorder that can be attached to the back of the phone and can be used for recording anytime and anywhere. You only need to turn a dial to start recording.

It is recommended that the back-stick recorder be used with our app, which can easily export, transcribe, and translate the recordings of the recorder.



3. Device buttons

The keypad functions of the recorder are as follows:

Button	Method	Effect
Power button	Long for 3 seconds	Turn on the recorder when it is off
	Long for 3 seconds	Turn off the recorder when it is on
	Long for 8 seconds	Reset
	Press 1 second	Shake it once and start recording
	Press 1 second	Tap the vibration button twice to end recording
Record button	Push up	Call record mode
	Push down	Normal record mode
Indicator light	Starting up	The white lights are always on
	Charging	The red light is always on
	Charge full	The green light is always on
	In the recording	The blue light is always on
	Low power/ disk space is insufficient	The lights are always on

4. Computer connection

Please use the data cable that comes standard with this product to connect the recorder to the computer, select [U disk] in [My Computer] and click to enter, then you can copy the recording files and other operations. The recording files are located in the RECORD folder.

Exit the device from the computer: Please eject the USB flash drive from the computer. Forced removal may cause data

The back-stick recorder needs to be used with the app to achieve real-time transcription, translation, and meeting summary.

6. Precautions

The contents of this section are designed for users to use this voice recorder correctly and ensure good performance of the voice recorder. Please read and comply with them carefully.

- ⌘ Do not severely impact the host.
- ⌘ Do not expose the host to chemicals such as benzene and thinners
- ⌘ Do not place the host close to strong magnetic fields or electric fields.
- ⌘ Do not put it in water or near high temperature.
- ⌘ Please do not disassemble, repair or manufacture by yourself.

Product built-in battery precautions

1. Do not disassemble, impact, squeeze or throw into fire;
2. If severe swelling occurs, do not continue to use it;
3. Do not place in high temperature environment;
4. Do not discard batteries at will to avoid environmental pollution. Please recycle them;
5. Lithium batteries must not be immersed in water.

7. Solutions to Common Problems

1. The recorder cannot be turned on:
 - ⌘ Please check if the battery is exhausted. Connect the device to a computer or charger and try to turn it on again.

2. Unable to download files:

- ⌘ Please confirm whether the computer and the recorder are connected correctly.
- ⌘ Please check whether the storage space of the internal memory is full.
- ⌘ Please check whether the USB cable is damaged.

The factory memory capacity of the product is determined by different conversion units and part of the capacity listed on the device will be used for formatting and other functions, not all for data storage. Therefore, there is a certain difference between the displayed capacity and the nominal capacity of the product, and the actual available data storage capacity will be lower than the capacity listed on the product.

When using a power adapter to connect the wire for charging, consumers should purchase and use a power adapter that has obtained CCC certification and meets the standard requirements .
