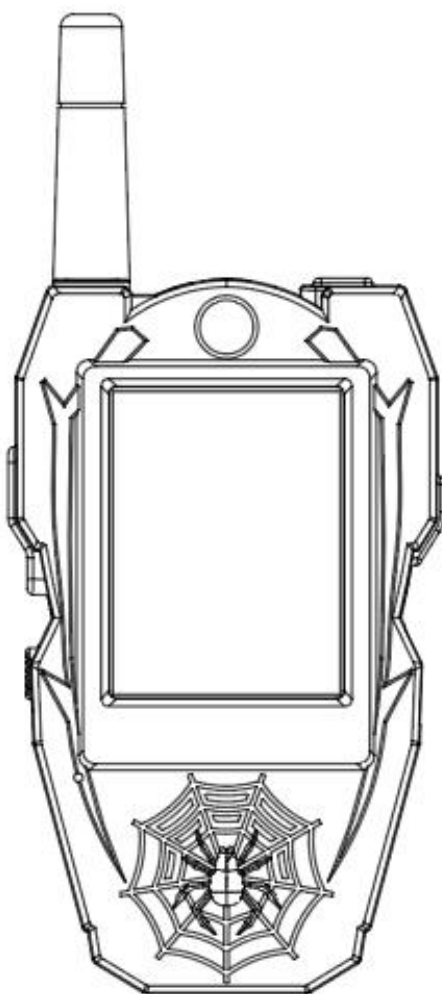


Walkie - Talkie

User Manual

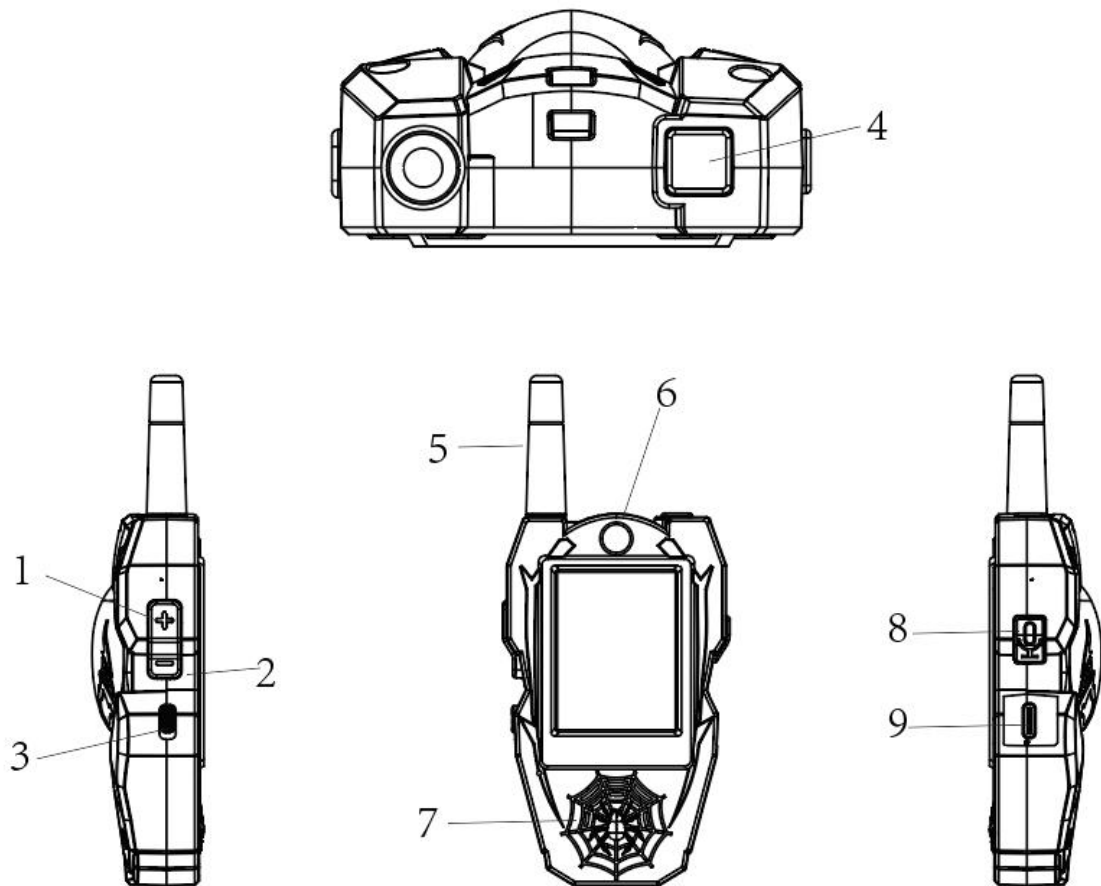


Before using this product, please read the user manual carefully.

I. Product Structure

Product Description



- (1) Volume Up Key (2) Volume Down Key (3) Power Switch
(4) Confirm/Voice Changer Key (5) Antenna (6) Lens
(7) Speaker (8) Intercom Key (9) Charging Port

II. Introduction to Keys and Basic Function Operations

1. Power On/Off

Toggle the 'Power Switch': Toggle up to power on, toggle down to power off.

2. Main Interface



- (1) Micro Chat
(2) Camera
(3) Album
(4) Settings

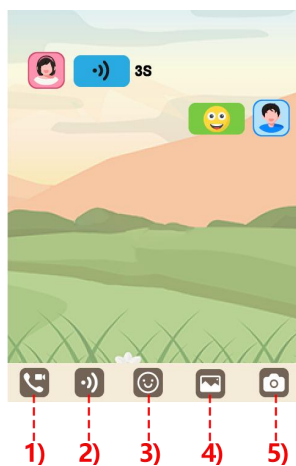
Main Interface Key Operations:

- (1) Press the 'Volume +/- Keys' to move left or right;
- (2) Long-press the 'Volume - Key' first to switch between AP mode (a green dot icon will appear in the upper left corner) / STA mode (a red dot icon will appear in the upper left corner), then long-press the 'Volume + Key' to pair devices;
- (3) Press the 'Confirm/Voice Changer Key' to enter the function.

3. Micro Chat:



Press the 'Volume +/- Keys' to select and move to , then press the 'Confirm/Voice Changer Key' to enter Micro Chat mode;



- (1) Video Chat
- (2) Voice
- (3) Emojis
- (4) Pictures
- (5) Photo Taking

Key Operations:

- (1) Press the 'Volume +/- Keys' to move left or right to select the bottom functions, and press the 'Confirm/Voice Changer Key' to enter;
- (2) Long-press the 'Confirm/Voice Changer Key' to exit Micro Chat.

Video Chat Operation:

- (1) Press the 'Confirm/Voice Changer Key' to select Video Chat, then dial and wait for the other party to answer. Press the 'Confirm/Voice Changer Key' to answer.
- (2) Press the 'Confirm/Voice Changer Key' to switch voice changer;
- (3) Press the 'Volume +/- Keys' to increase or decrease the volume. Long-press the 'Volume + Key' to switch the video window display, and long-press the 'Volume - Key' to switch stickers and filters;
- (4) Long-press the 'Intercom Key' for voice intercom;
- (5) Long-press the 'Confirm/Voice Changer Key' to end the video chat.

Voice Intercom Operation:

Long-press to talk, release to end and send.

Emoji Operation:

Press the 'Volume +/- Keys' to move left or right to select an emoji, and press the 'Confirm/Voice Changer Key' to send.

Picture Operation:

- (1) Press the 'Volume +/- Keys' to move left or right to select a picture, and press the 'Intercom Key' to send;
- (2) Long-press the 'Volume - Key' on the picture selection interface to bring up the delete menu;
- (3) Long-press the 'Confirm/Voice Changer Key' to return to the Micro Chat interface.

Photo Taking Operation:

- (1) Press the 'Confirm/Voice Changer Key' to take a photo and send it;
- (2) Press the 'Intercom Key' to switch stickers and filters;
- (3) Long-press the 'Confirm/Voice Changer Key' to return to the Micro Chat interface.

4. Camera



Press the 'Volume +/- Keys' to select and move to , then press the

'Confirm/Voice Changer Key' to enter Camera mode;

- (1) Press the 'Confirm/Voice Changer Key' to take a photo and save it;
- (2) Press the 'Intercom Key' to switch stickers and filters;
- (3) Long-press the 'Confirm/Voice Changer Key' to return to the main interface;

5. Album



Press the 'Volume +/- Keys' to select and move to , then press the

'Confirm/Voice Changer Key' to enter Album mode;

- (1) Press the 'Volume +/- Keys' to move left or right to select a picture, press the 'Confirm/Voice Changer Key' to view it, and press again to return to the preview interface;
- (2) Long-press the 'Volume - Key' on the picture selection interface to bring up the delete menu;
- (3) Long-press the 'Confirm/Voice Changer Key' to return to the main interface.

6. Settings



Press the 'Volume +/- Keys' to select and move to , then press the

'Confirm/Voice Changer Key' to enter Settings mode;

- (1) Press the 'Volume +/- Keys' to move up or down to select a setting, and press the 'Confirm/Voice Changer Key' to confirm, modify and save;
- (2) Long-press the 'Confirm/Voice Changer Key' to return to the main interface.

7. Reminding

- (1) The red light stays on during charging and turns off once the battery is fully charged.
- (2) Use a 5V 1A charger to charge the walkie-talkie. Do not use a charger with a

specification exceeding 5V 2A, otherwise it may damage the device or cause other losses.

(3)This device is not waterproof. Please keep it away from water sources.
