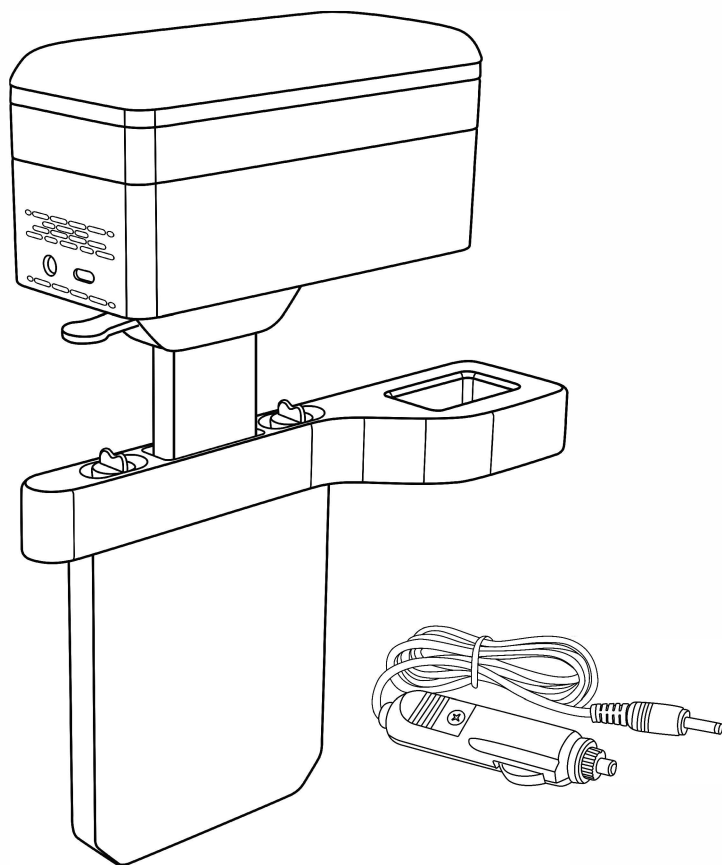

DriveMate Armrest Manual

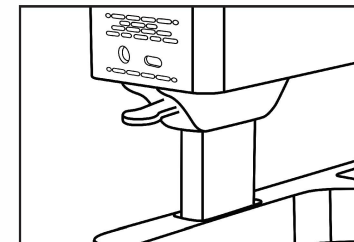


This product is a multi-functional vehicle-mounted device designed to enhance driver comfort, convenience, and interior tidiness, for an optimized driving experience.

Key Features & Specifications

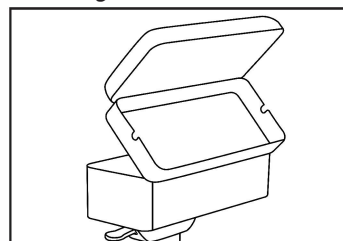
1 Adjustable Height Armrest

- Adjustment Method: Press the button at the bottom of the armrest box to easily adjust height for different needs.
- Adjustment Range: 9-level adjustment range ensures comfort during driving.
- Stability: Locked firmly after adjustment; no loosening during travel.



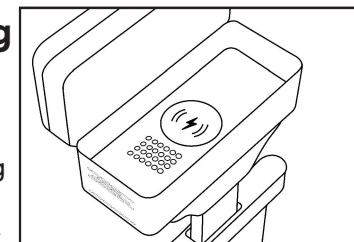
2 Dual-Layer Storage Box

- Layers: Dual compartments (upper/lower) for flexible organization.
- Opening Method: Flip-top design for quick access.
- Suitable Items: Upper layer for cards, coins, sunglasses; lower layer for phones, wallets, keys.



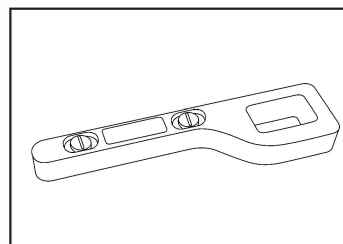
3 Maximum 15W Wireless Fast Charging

- Phone Compatibility: Width less than 82mm.
- Charging Method: Place Devices that support wireless charging on the charging pad to start charging.
- Supported Devices: Devices that support wireless charging (such as Apple, Samsung).
- Charging Efficiency: Maximum 15W fast charging for quick power replenishment.
- Cooling Fan: Reduces heat during charging, enhancing stability and device lifespan.



4 Seat Gap Filler

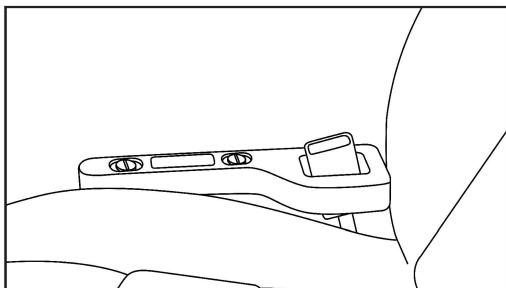
- Purpose: Prevents items from falling into seat gaps, maintaining interior tidiness.
- Installation: Slide filler onto seatbelt base and insert into seat gap for securely in place.
- Effect: Eliminates item loss and improves driving experience.



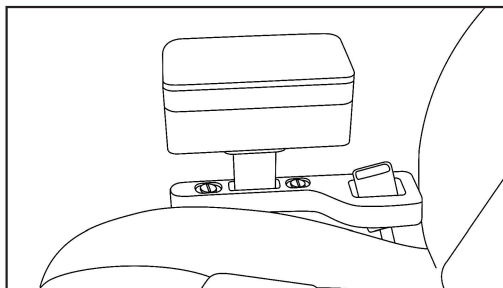
5 65W Docking Station

- Specifications:
 - A: 5521DC Input (10W) – Connects to vehicle power.
 - B: USB-C Output (30W) – Fast-charge phones/laptops/tablets/earphones.
 - C: Wireless Charging Output(15W)– Fast-charge phones/earphones.
 - D: A+C Output PCBA (Combined Output 20W)–Fast-charge phones/earphones.

2-Step Installation

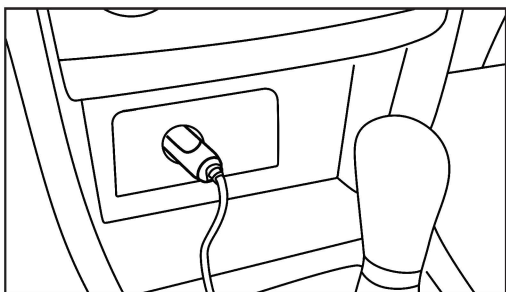


① Insert the base into the seat gap while attaching the gap filler to the seatbelt base.



② Slide the armrest body into the base track and adjust to desired height via the button.

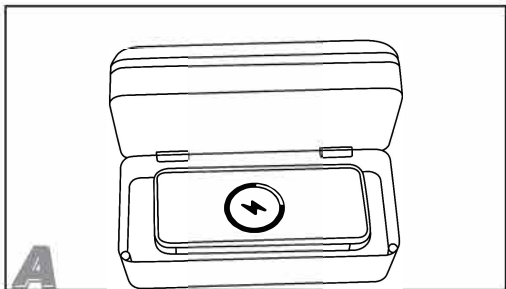
15W Wireless Charging Instructions



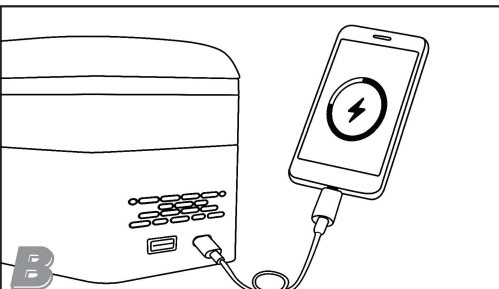
• Power Connection

Connect the DriveMate's power cable to the vehicle's cigarette lighter socket and start the vehicle's power.

• Device Placement



Place wireless charging compatible devices on the lower storage box's charging area.



Use docking station ports for non-wireless devices.

• End Charging

Remove device from charging area; fan stops automatically.

Precautions

- 1.Contact customer service for any issues.
- 2.Do not adjust the armrest height while driving.

Maintenance

- 1.Regular Cleaning: Wipe surface with soft cloth; avoid corrosive cleaners.
- 2.Cable Inspection: Check for damage/wear; replace if necessary. Keep cables away from heat/moisture.

Troubleshooting

• No Charging

- 1.Confirm device supports wireless charging and is properly aligned with charging coil.
- 2.Verify the power cable is firmly connected to the vehicle's cigarette lighter port and the vehicle power is running.

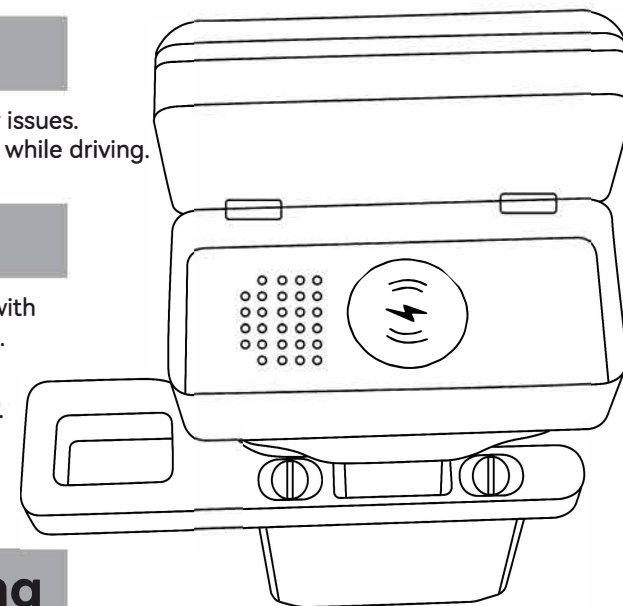
• Slow Charging

- 1.Clean charging area; avoid high temperatures/humidity.
- 2.Check device battery health (aging batteries may reduce efficiency).
