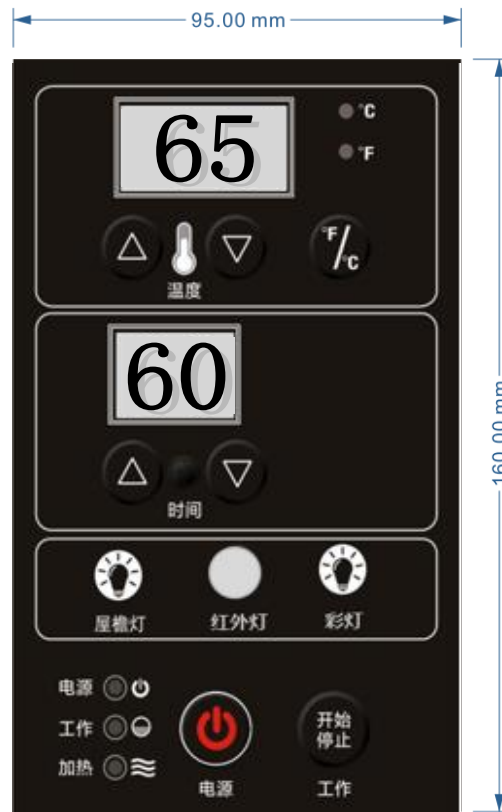

1、Panel Operation Instructions



1. Power On/Off Button: Press this button to turn on or off the control system after connecting the power supply.

2. Start/Stop Button: In the power-on state, press this button to start or stop heating. The panel indicator light will go out when heating stops and stay on when heating continues.

3. Color Light Button: In the power-connected state, press this button to turn on the color lights; press again to turn them off. Long press the color light button to enter the color switching mode. The panel will display 2n: 1. White 2. Purple 3. Blue 4. Cyan 5. Green 6. Yellow 7. Red 8. Orange 9. Pink 10. Gradient/Cycle (starts from the first color). It will automatically exit this function if there is no operation for 15 seconds.



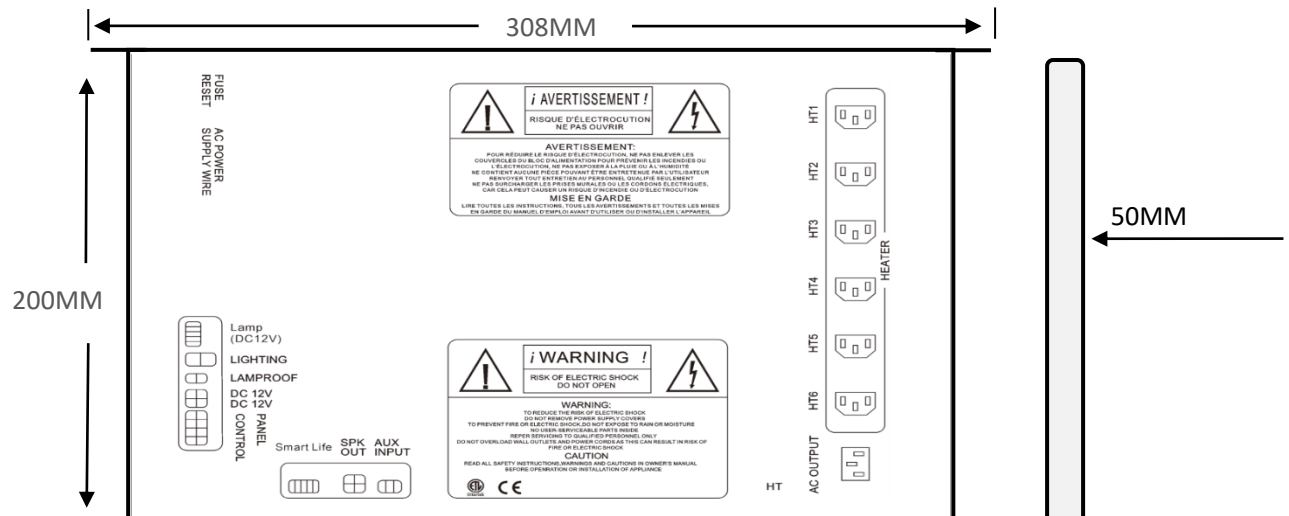
4. Eaves Light Button: In the power-connected state, press this button to turn on the eaves light; press again to turn it off. (Eaves Light: i.e., Lighting Lamp) .
5. Time +/- Buttons: In the power-on state, press the "+" or "-" button once to adjust the set heating time to the desired duration, with a step of 1 minute.
6. Temperature +/- Buttons: In the power-on state, press the "+" or "-" button once to adjust the set temperature to the desired value, with a step of 1°C.
7. C/F Button: In the working state, press this button to switch between Celsius (° C) and Fahrenheit (° F) units.

2、Bluetooth Function Operation Instructions

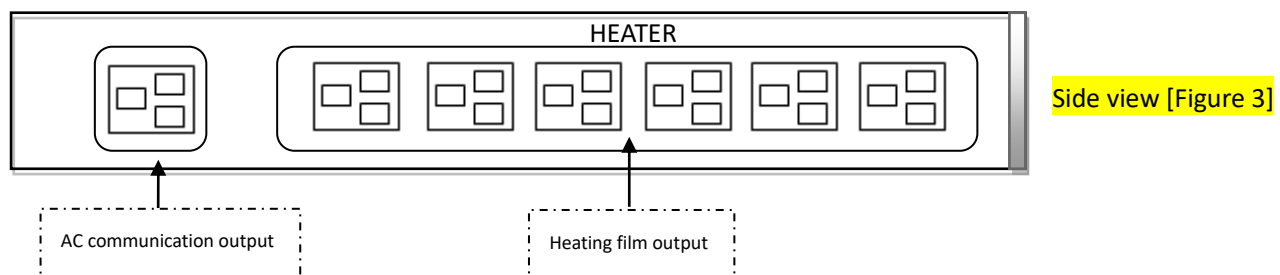
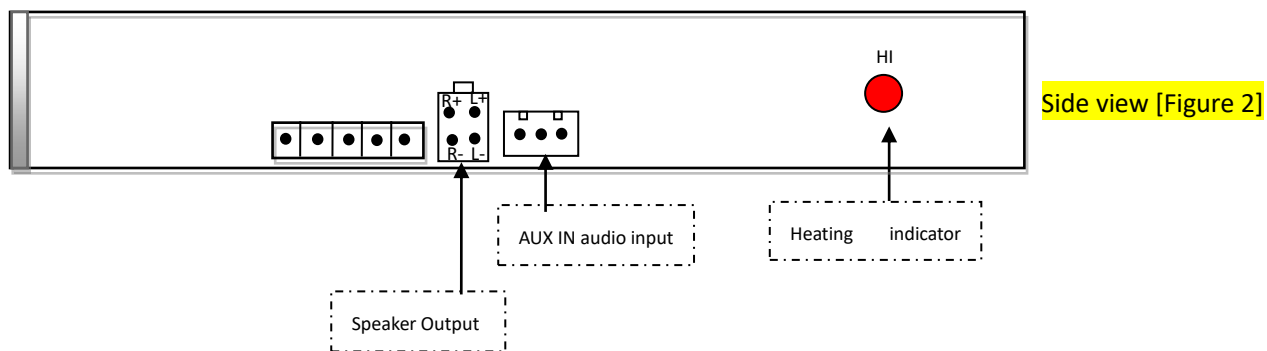
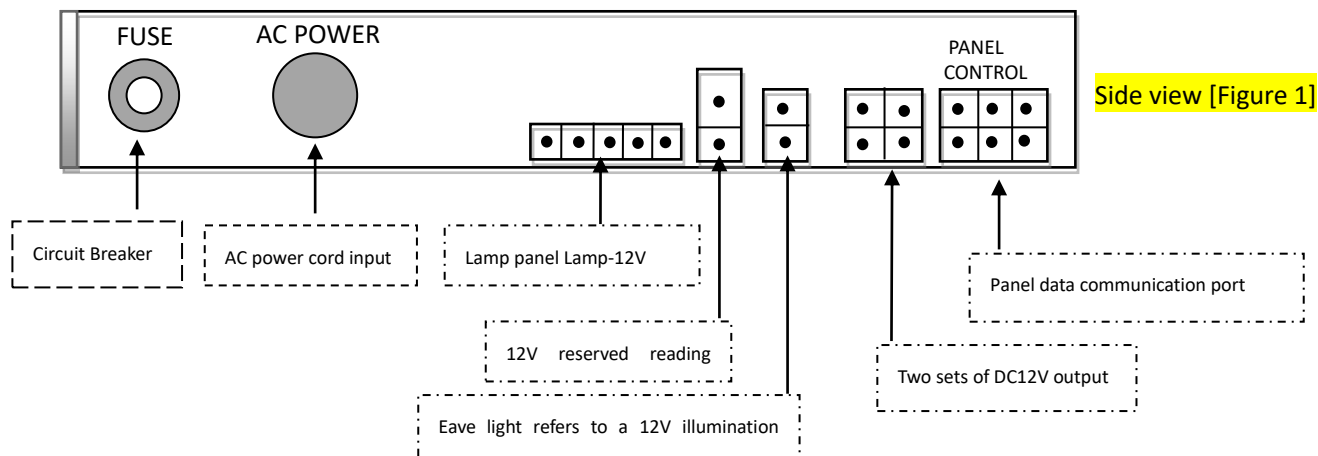
In the power-on state or when any light is on, turn on the Bluetooth function on your mobile phone to search for and connect to this product's Bluetooth device (device name: BT-Sauna). Once the mobile phone shows "Connected", you can play your favorite music.。
