

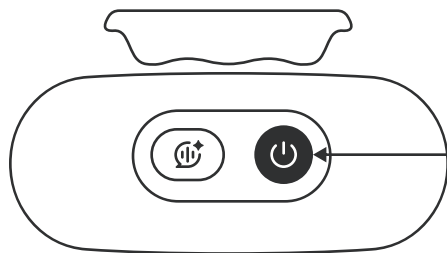
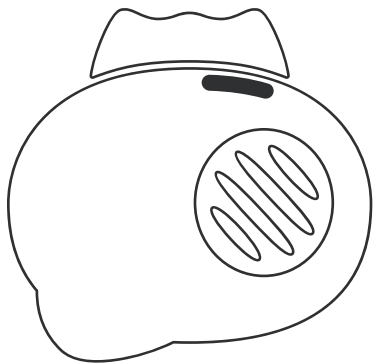


PettiChat

INSTRUCTION

Getting Started

- 1 Search and download **PettiChat mobile app** from App Store, Google Play, or **pettichat.com**.
- 2 Create your **PettiChat** account — tap **Sign Up** and follow the steps.
- 3 Take out the device and press the **Power** Button for 1 second.
When you hear the **start voice** prompt, the device is on.

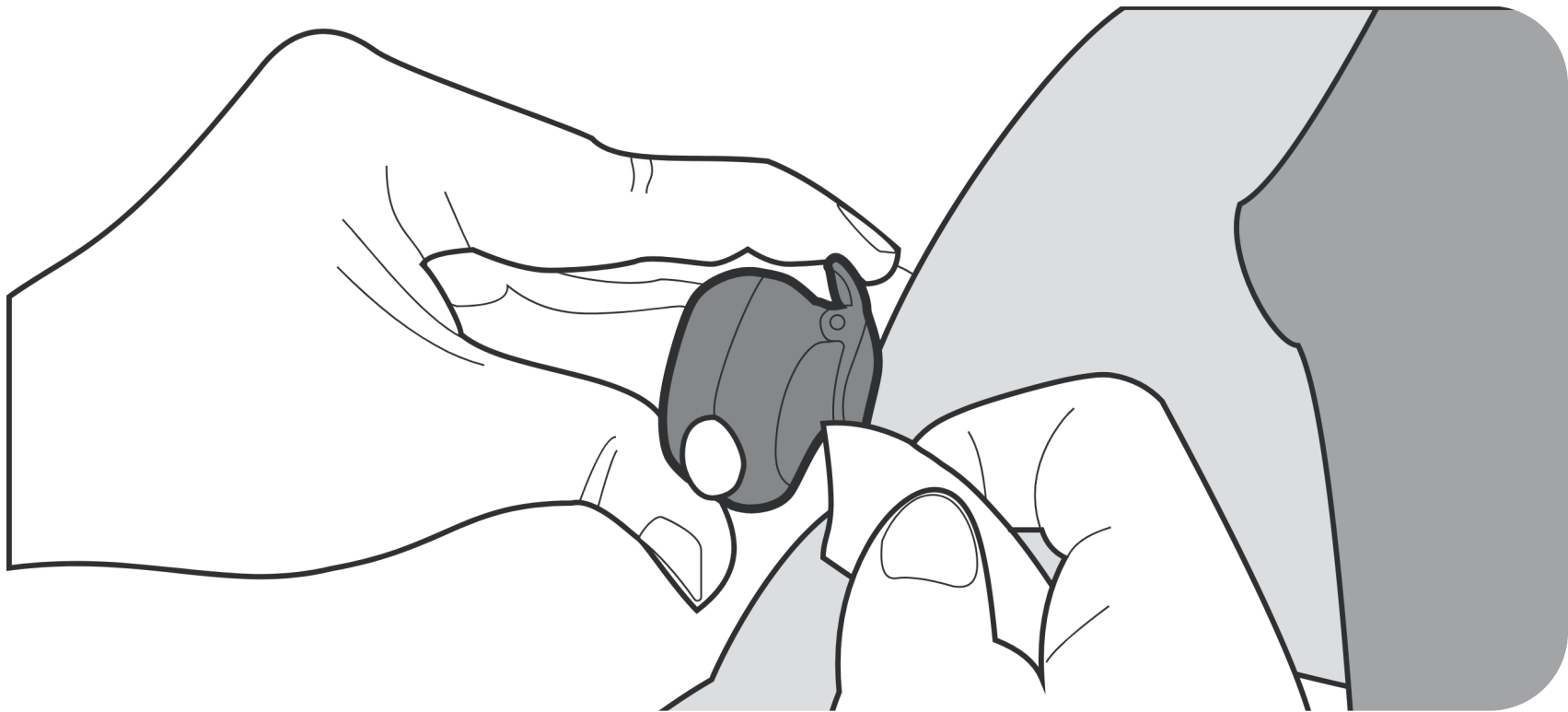

Getting Started

- 4 The device will automatically enter **Wi-Fi setup** mode, accompanied by a voice prompt. Open the **PettiChat App** to complete your **pet profile setup** and **network configuration**.
- 5 After the setup is completed, the device will **automatically restart** and get everything ready. You can then **clip the device** onto your pet's collar or clothing.
- 6 Start using PettiChat! When your pet **makes a sound**, PettiChat will translate it into a human-like voice.
You may also start a conversation by using the wake-up word.
"Hello, Hello" + your pet's name (e.g., "Hello, hello, Pipi!")
- 7 You can check the **chat history** and your pet's **location** in the app. You can also change your pet's voice and character settings.

How to clip



Functions

1 **Pet sound translation**

When your pet vocalizes or performs certain recognizable actions, the device detects the patterns and converts them into human-like speech using PettiChat algorithms, then plays the message through the device.

2 **Pet conversation**

Say “Hello Hello” followed by your pet’s name (e.g., “Hello Hello Pipi”) to start chatting with your pet.

3 **Pet tracking**

The device can locate your pet with an accuracy of around 5 meters. Battery life in tracking-only mode lasts up to 4 days.

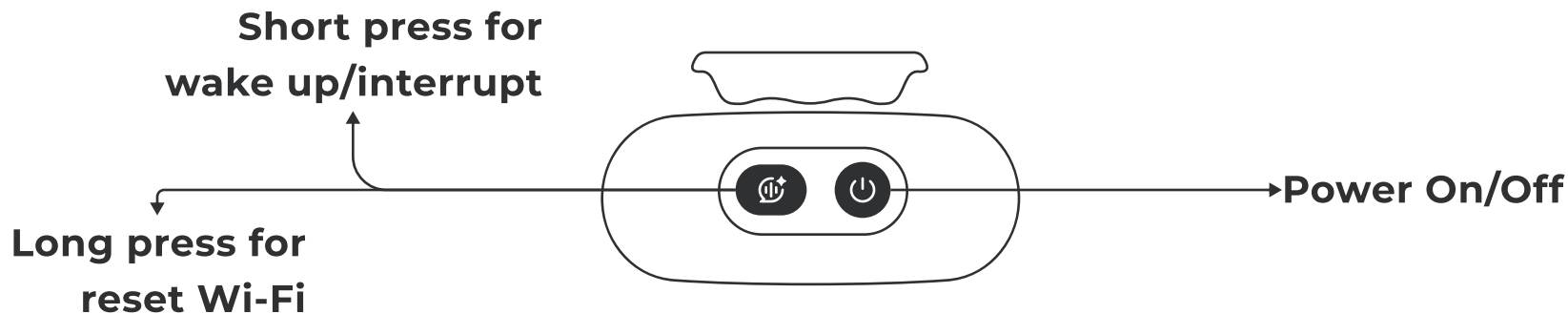

Warnings
