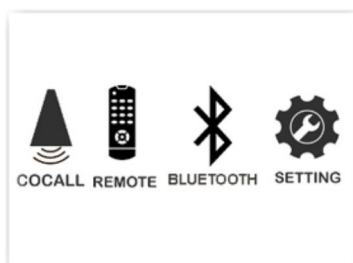

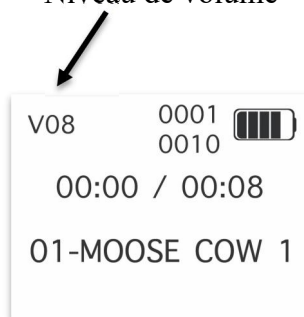

Getting started

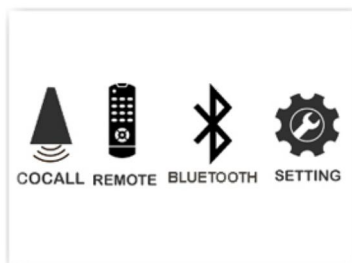
Battery Charging

Connect the Cocall to USB connector with included wire. The Screen will be showing the battery level.
Charging fully before use it.

- Bluetooth : COCALL HUNT app

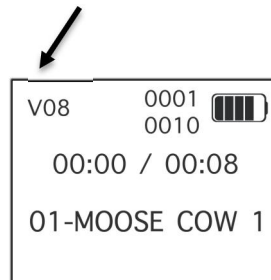


Press MENU to select

Card playing mode (Cycle mode)

In Cocall mode, Press MENU, then select cycle mode to access 3 card playing modes.

- Normal: Cycles through all programed calls on card.
- Repeat one: Plays one selected call on repeat.
- ONE: Plays one selected call once and stops
