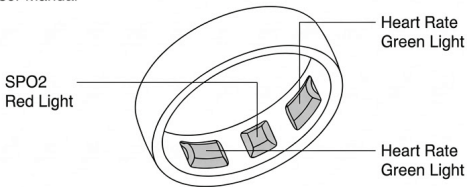

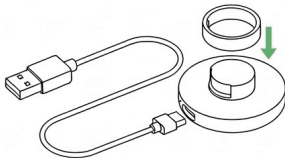
Overview and Packaging

Smart Ring, Charging Cable, Charging Dock and User Manual



Power On

Put smart ring at charging dock. Connect the charging dock to USB to charge and activate smart ring.



Wearing Method

Wear the ring on your suitable finger and choose a comfortable size. Suggest wear it on the index finger, middle finger, and ring finger for better monitoring of data.



Please let the sensor on the inside of your fingers for more accurate measurement of heart rate and blood oxygen when wear it.

Download the CNICK app for iOS or Android and follow the on-screen instructions to set up and activate your ring.
