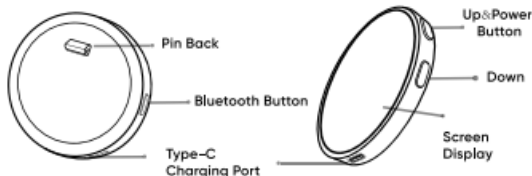

**Turn On/Off** 1.Press and hold the Power button for 3s to turn on/off.

## Transfer Images via Bluetooth from Phone

1.Scan the QR code to download VivaMark app.

2.Tap the bluetooth button to enter pairing mode.Open the app and tap the connection status button to pair.

## Screen Operations

1.Swipe left/right to switch images.

2.Swipe down from the top to enter menu.

3.Power saving icon:Toggle between always on/sleep mode(enters sleep mode after 10 minutes of inactivity).

4.Delete icon:Delete images(swipe left/right to switch images before deleting).

5.Flashlight icon:Enter Cheer Light mode.

6.Brightness icon:Adjust brightness(use up/down button to change the brightness level).

**Clock** 1.Tap the clock icon to enter clock display.

## Cheer Light

·Pull down the menu and tap the flashlight icon.

·Swipe up/down to select a color.Tap to switch flashing effects.

·Swipe from right to left to start the color cycle mode.

Swipe again to stop.)

·Swipe from left to right to exit.

## Share Images Between Devices(within 10m)

·Device A:Press and hold the bluetooth button.

·Device B:Press the bluetooth button twice quickly.

·Press the bluetooth button to receive images.

## Precautions

·Usage time is affected by brightness settings.Adjust reasonably.

·Transfer times will be longer for video and GIF files due to their larger size.

·The bluetooth range (within 10m)may be reduced by walls or obstacles.Avoid long-distance use.

## Troubleshooting

·Bluetooth connection fails:Restart the device and app,refresh pairing,and ensure the phone bluetooth is on.

·Content not displaying:Re-upload files or check if memory is full.

·Buttons unresponsive:Press and hold the Power button for 10 s to force restart.
