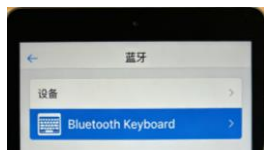
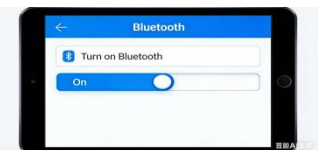


1. Product Features

- Bluetooth wireless connection + scissor-switch key structure for comfortable typing
- Built-in rechargeable polymer lithium battery
- Auto-sleep after 10 minutes of inactivity (low power consumption, long battery life)

2. Pairing Instructions

1. Power on the keyboard.
2. Press and hold the **Connect** button for 3 seconds until the blue LED flashes.
3. On your device: open Bluetooth settings → select **Bluetooth Keyboard** → enter pairing code (if prompted) to connect. *Note: No re-pairing needed after first successful connection.*

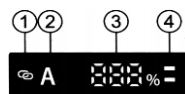

Input method switch: Control + Space or Fn + ☐

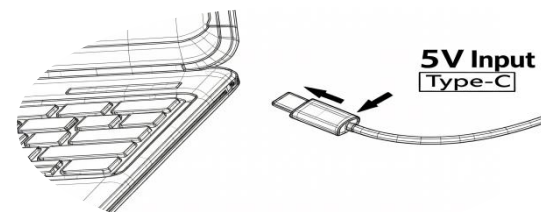
4. Indicator Guide

- 1. Bluetooth indicator: Flashes during pairing:
- 2. Caps LED: Lights up when Caps Lock is active
- 3. Battery Status.
- 4. When charging, the bars on the display flash alternately. When fully charged, the bars stay on steadily.



5. Charging Instructions

1. First use: Charge for **≥6 hours**.
1. 2. Low battery (%LED flashes): Charge for **≥2 hours**.
2. 3. Connect USB cable to the keyboard's charging port (as shown in diagram).



6. Troubleshooting

Ensure Bluetooth is enabled and device is within **10m**.

2. Check pairing password (if required).
3. Charge the keyboard if battery is low.
4. If issues persist:
 - Delete "Bluetooth Keyboard" from your device's Bluetooth list.
 - Restart keyboard and device.
 - Re-pair following Section 2 steps.
