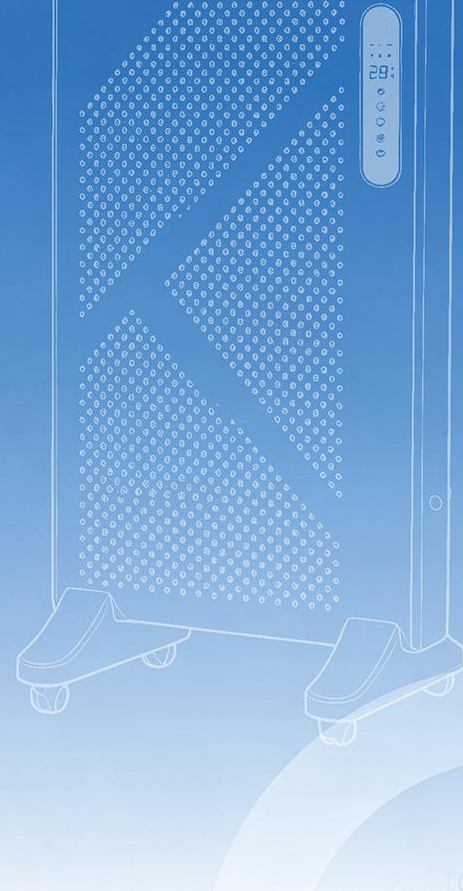

III. Before Use

1. Transportation and Storage

Handle the product with care during loading and transit. Do not throw, drop, roll, or drag it. Protect it from direct sunlight and rain.

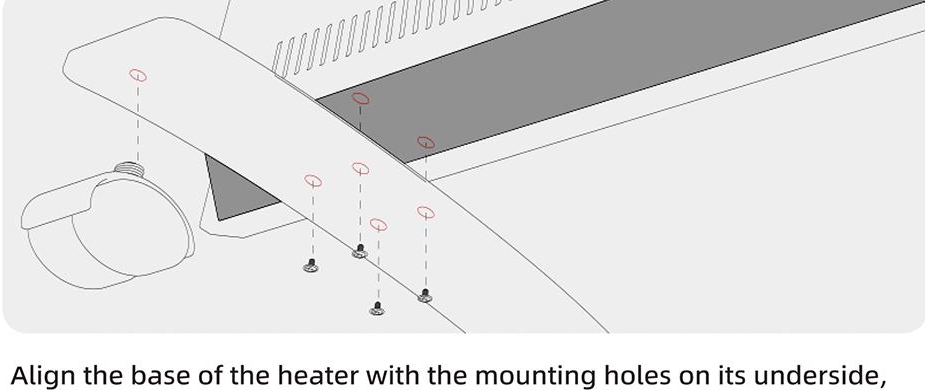
The storage area must be well-ventilated, free of corrosive gases, and maintain a relative humidity of no more than 85%.

Do not place heavy objects on top of the packaging, store it outdoors, or stack more than six cartons high.

IV. Installation Options

This heater is designed for freestanding installation only.

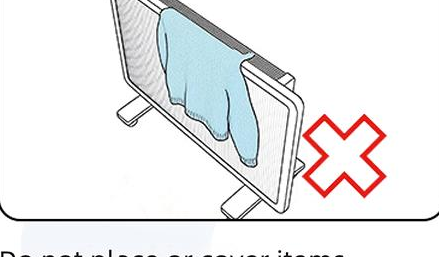
★ FREESTANDING



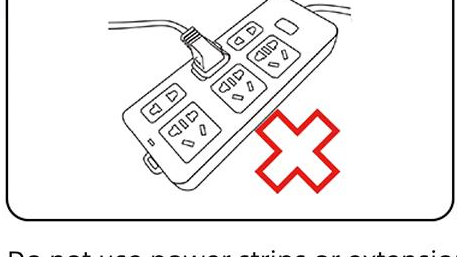
Align the base of the heater with the mounting holes on its underside, then secure it with screws.

Insert the caster wheels into the holes on the base and tighten the screws firmly.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS



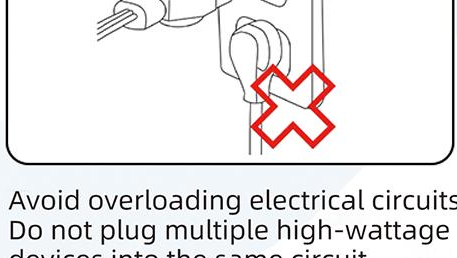
Do not place or cover items (e.g., clothing) on top of the heater.



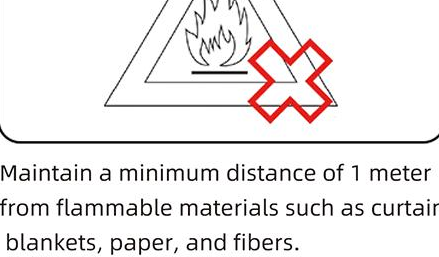
Do not use power strips or extension cords, as they may overheat or damage the plug due to excessive power draw.



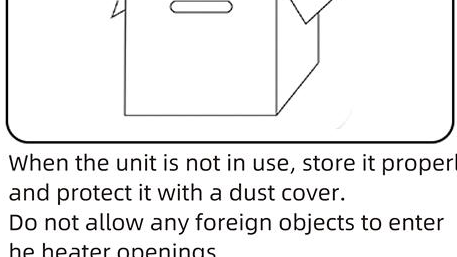
Keep children and pets away from the unit to prevent injury or tipping.



Avoid overloading electrical circuits. Do not plug multiple high-wattage devices into the same circuit.

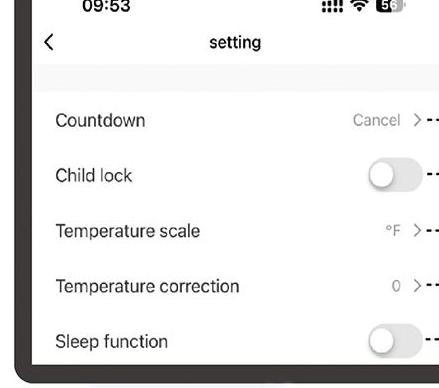


Maintain a minimum distance of 1 meter from flammable materials such as curtains, blankets, paper, and fibers.



When the unit is not in use, store it properly and protect it with a dust cover. Do not allow any foreign objects to enter the heater openings.

APP FUNCTION



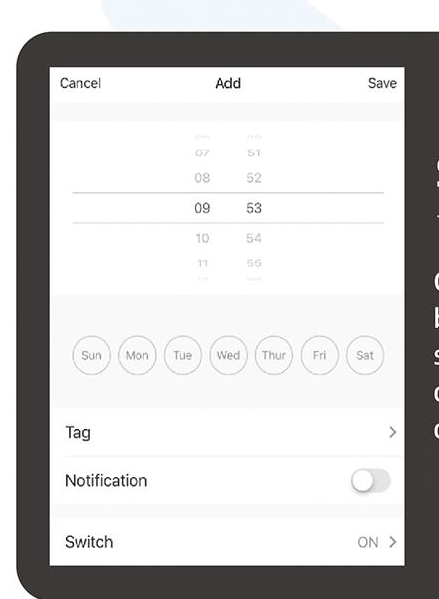
Turn on/off countdown

Turn on/off sleep mode



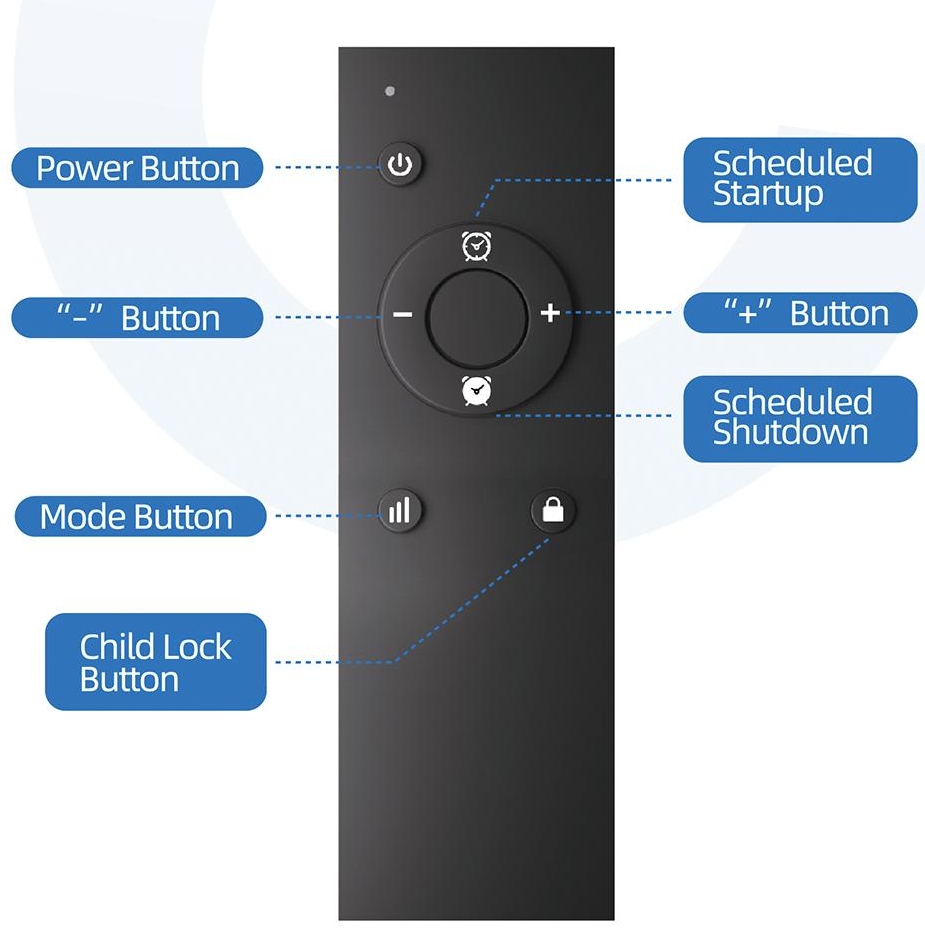
Schedule Function

Create a custom heating schedule based on your needs. You can set specific on/off times for each hour of the day and choose which days of the week the schedule repeats.

REMOTE CONTROL BUTTONS

Power Button, Mode Button, Timer Button, "+" Button, "-" Button, Sleep Button, Child Lock Button.

The functions of the remote control buttons are the same as those on the control panel.

5. This heater becomes hot during use. To avoid burns, do not allow bare skin to touch hot surfaces. Always use the handle when moving the unit.

4. Plug this appliance directly into a wall socket. Power strips and extension cords are not designed to handle the high wattage of this heater.

3. To reduce the risk of fire, keep textiles, curtains, and any other flammable materials at a minimum distance of 1 meter from the air outlet.

2. Extreme caution is required when this heater is used by or near children or individuals requiring supervision, especially when left operating unattended.

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
