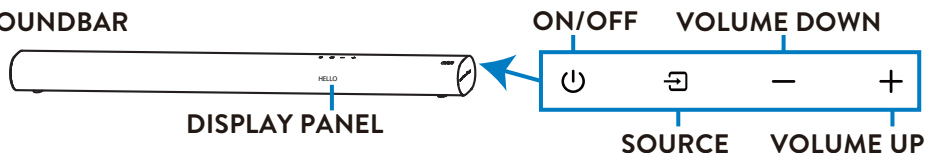

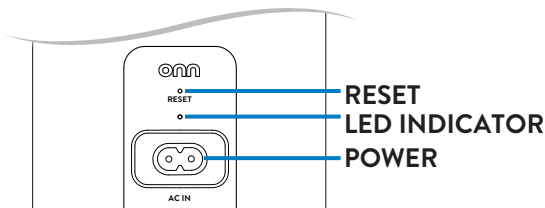

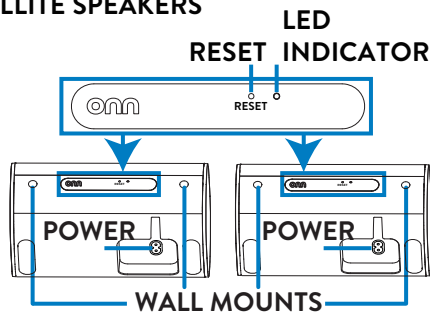

Function	Display	Action & Result
Power on / off	HELLO / BYE	Press  x 1 to power on / off the soundbar
Auto standby	AUTO STANDBY ON / AUTO STANDBY OFF	• Press and hold  for 3 seconds to go to auto standby setting after powered on • Press  /  to switch auto standby on / off • Press  / OK to confirm your selection
Input source scanning	SCAN	• Soundbar will search for the latest input source after powered on. If there's no input in 3 seconds, it will start to scan other wired input sources • Press  to quit input source scanning
HDMI (eARC/ARC)	eARC / ARC	• Press  to switch to HDMI(eARC/ARC) • Connect the soundbar to TV's HDMI(eARC) /ARC, and set the TV's source to HDMI(eARC/ARC)
HDMI IN	HDMI	Press  repeatedly to switch to HDMI IN
Optical	OPT	Press  repeatedly to switch to Optical
Aux in	AUX	Press  repeatedly to switch to AUX
USB	USB	Press  repeatedly to switch to USB

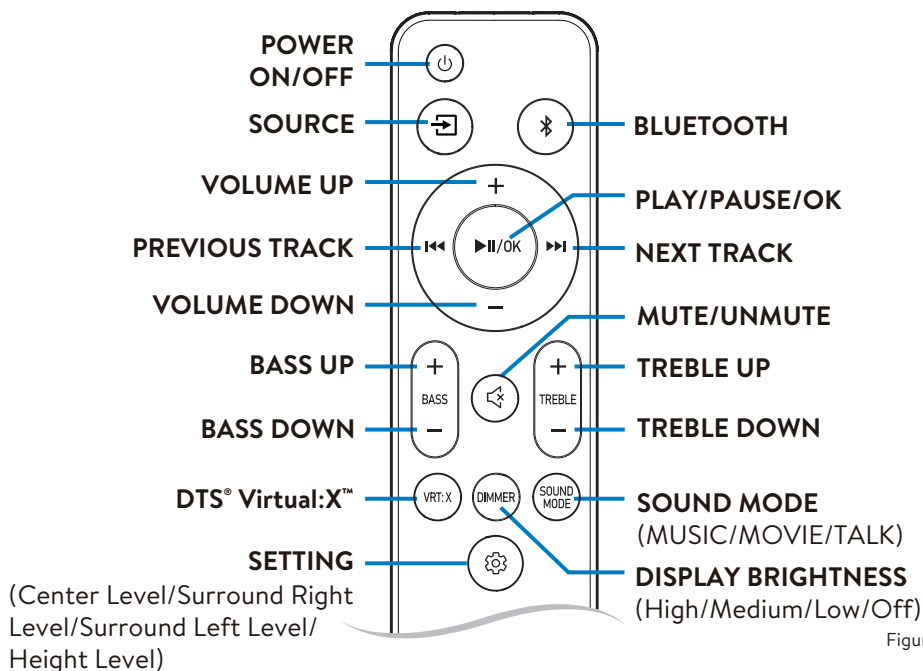

*Press "VRT:X" to enable/disable Virtual:X. When enabled (On), all inputs will produce a virtual sound technology that simulates the effect of having overhead sound. When disabled (Off), all sources will playback without virtualization.

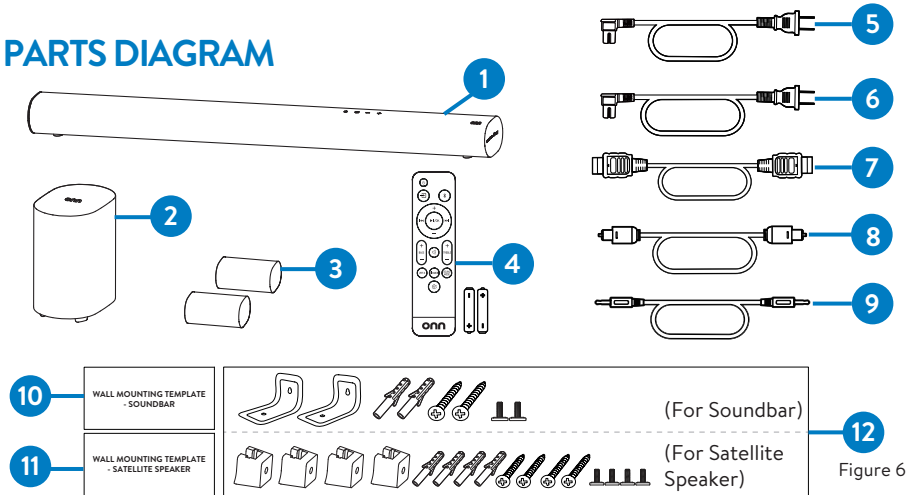

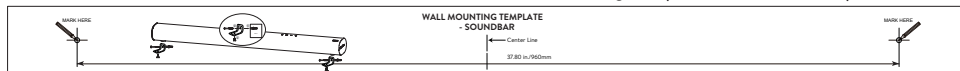

ON A SURFACE



1A. CENTER

1. Center the soundbar below the TV, close to ear level.
2. Go to First Time Setup for further instructions.

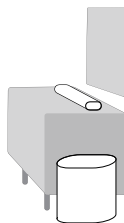
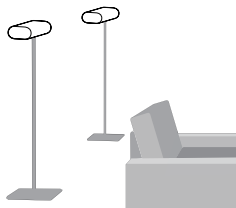

1B. PLACE

2. Mark Bracket holes (Ensure enough space between Soundbar and TV) See 3B. HANG.

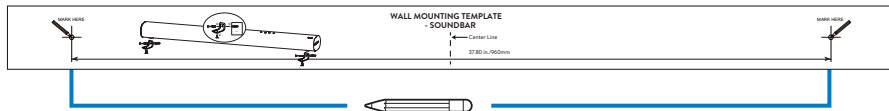
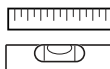

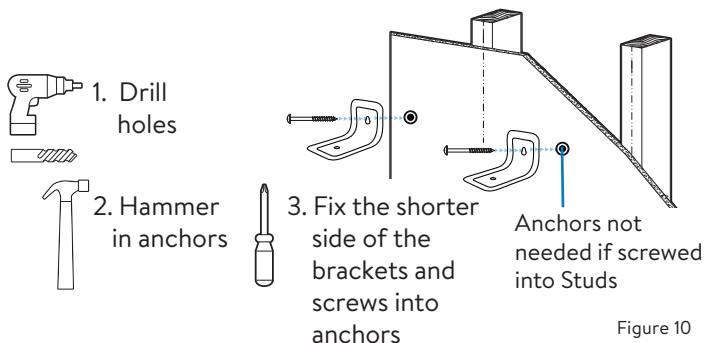

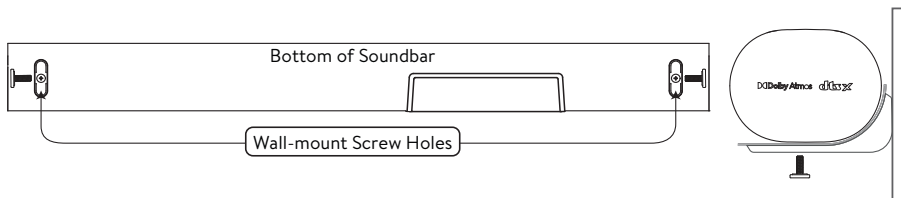

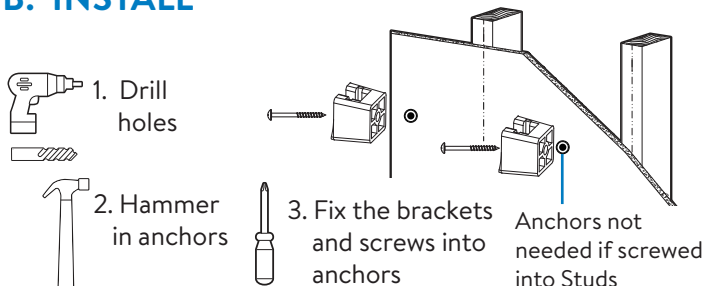

2B. HANG

1. Go to First Time Setup to connect the cable.
2. Attach the wall mount screw to the back of the satellite speakers.
3. Slide the speakers on to the wall brackets. Ensure the wall mount screw is secured within the bracket grooves.

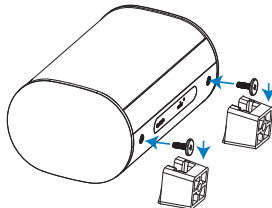

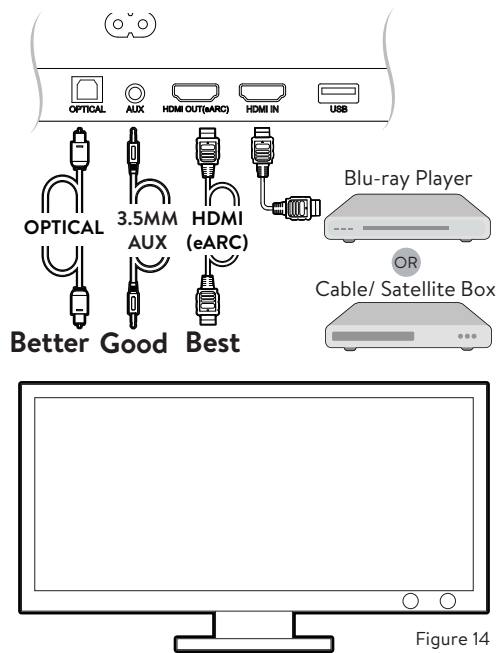

First Time Setup

1. CHOOSE A CABLE

Connect one cable to Soundbar and TV



- To Enjoy **Dolby** Atmos or DTS:X® content, your TV must support HDMI-CEC and enhanced Audio Return Channel (eARC) function.
- Enable CEC and ARC/eARC on TV
- Settings for CEC and ARC/eARC may differ by TV manufacturer. See TV's user guide for more.
- To control soundbar volume on TV remote, enable System Audio Control in CEC menu.
- CEC Function naming may differ by TV Manufacturer. See TV's user guide for more.
- Only HDMI 2.0 cables (and higher) support eARC.
- * If no Audio using Digital Inputs see troubleshooting.

Tips: If you have a Roku TV®, setup will be easy. Just use the included HDMI cable to connect your soundbar to the HDMI (ARC/eARC) port on your TV and follow the on-screen instructions.

Power on the Soundbar, then it will pair with Subwoofer and Satellites automatically within 3-5 seconds.

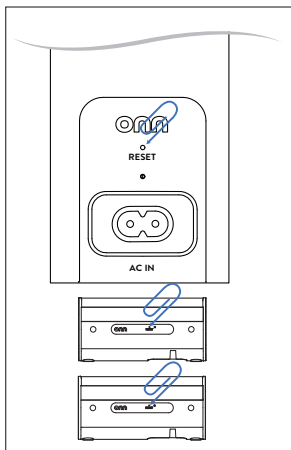

CONNECT SUBWOOFER & SATELLITES

1B. MANUAL PAIRING (IF AUTOMATIC PAIRING FAILED)

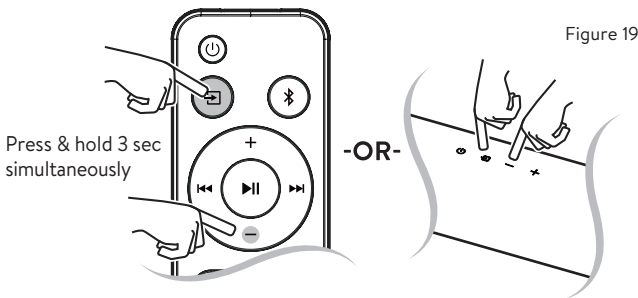
1. Plug into the power supply.
2. Press and hold the reset hole of the subwoofer and satellite speakers for 1 second with a pin.
3. Press "⏻" and "-" simultaneously for 3 seconds on the soundbar or remote control.
4. When wireless connection is successful, the indicator will be solid blue.

The indicators will flash rapidly when pairing



WARNING

Place the subwoofer and satellite speakers within 8m range of the soundbar.

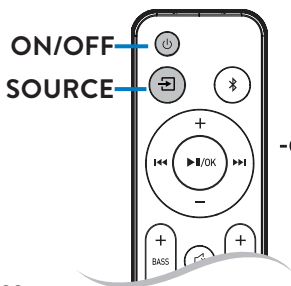

Controlled by Device, Remote Control or Soundbar



WARNING

High volume levels can damage your hearing. Reduce the volume levels before pressing Play.

Bluetooth use

Your Soundbar supports music streaming from smartphones, tablets, and computers with Bluetooth capability.

Device compatibility will vary, see your device's documentation for more information. Once you have paired your source device to the Soundbar, as long as you stay within range of the Soundbar, your device should remain paired.

If the input is changed, the Bluetooth device will disconnect. If the source is changed back to Bluetooth, any paired Bluetooth device will reconnect automatically.

A Bluetooth signal has a range of up to 30 feet. Keep in mind that Bluetooth is a compressed audio format, so streamed music may lose some integrity when compared to a wired connection.

USB OPERATION



1. INSERT THE USB DEVICE

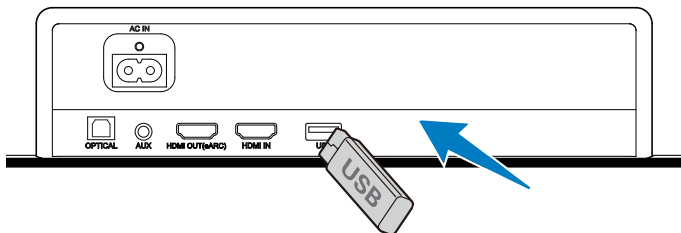

Select USB Mode(Remote Control or Soundbar  button)

▶ /OK	Play, pause or resume play.
◀◀/▶▶	Skip to the previous or next track.
+/-	Increase/decrease the volume.

Cleaning & Care

CLEANING

- Wipe down surfaces with a light cloth.
- Never use abrasive pads to clean device.
- Avoid using liquids to clean device.



CAUTION

Ensure the unit is fully unplugged from the power supply before cleaning.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Cause	Solution
No power	Power off	Press "⏻" button on remote control or Soundbar
	Loose power cord	Ensure the power cord is securely connected
	Faulty outlet	Plug a different device into the electrical outlet to verify that the outlet is working correctly
No audio	Low Volume / Mute	Press "🔊" " Increase volume
	Some TVs do not Pass through Digital Audio*	Change TV output to PCM
	Input source	Select different Input source
	Not All TVs have Audio outputs listed	Connect directly to another device (Blu-Ray, Game System, etc.)
	TV set to variable audio output	Set audio output to fixed or standard, NOT variable
	Bluetooth source device	Increase volume / unmute source device
	Audio source is mono**	Switch to a stereo or multi-channel audio source

**When the audio source is mono, it cannot get through to upfiring speakers.

Problem	Cause	Solution
Bluetooth breakup or disconnect	Subwoofer is too distant from Soundbar	The subwoofer is out of range, please move the subwoofer closer to the soundbar. Make sure the subwoofer is within 8m range of the soundbar
	Source too far	Move the source device closer to soundbar
	Solid obstruction	Move source device into line-of-site of soundbar
	Other wireless devices	Turn off / move devices away (wireless security cameras,wireless video baby monitors, cordless phones, and microwave ovens
