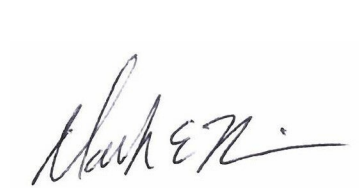
We, Hewlett Packard Enterprise Company, attest that this device under FCC ID: Q9DAPINH721 complies with device protocol requirements and operational restrictions: for a Low Power Indoor Access Point (6ID).

Low Power Indoor Access Point (6ID):

1. Protocol Statement – The AP uses IEEE 802.11 beacon signalling to inform the associated client/subordinate device of its permitted maximum power. The beacon includes a 6 GHz Operation Information subfield, which identifies the AP as an LPI AP and includes a Maximum Transmit Power Interpretation subfield
2. Device Restrictions – We acknowledge the following:
 - a. The AP is powered from either a Power-over-Ethernet connection, or an AC power adapter. It is not battery powered.
 - b. The AP uses integrated antennas.
 - c. The AP does not have a weatherized enclosure.
 - d. The AP will not be allowed on oil platforms, cars, trains, boats, and aircraft, except that operation of this device is permitted in large aircraft while flying above 10,000 feet only in the 5.925-6.425 GHz Band.
 - e. The AP is prohibited for control of or communication with unmanned aircraft systems, including drones.
